

AGREEMENT

FOR AN ARTICULATED "THREE PLUS ONE" PROGRAM BACHELOR OF SCIENCE in BIOLOGY or HEALTH SCIENCES AND DOCTOR of CHIROPRACTIC BETWEEN University of Wisconsin—Platteville and any Council on Chiropractic Education accredited Doctor of Chiropractic program.

INTRODUCTION

Based upon a mutual respect for the integrity of parallel academic programs and in an effort to better serve students intending to pursue the chiropractic profession, the University of Wisconsin-Platteville (UW-Platteville) will offer a "Three Plus One" program. This offering will allow UW-Platteville students to finish the fourth year (30 credits) of an undergraduate degree from UW-Platteville by completing the first year of the Doctor of Chiropractic program at any Council on Chiropractic Education (CCE) accredited chiropractic college and transferring those chiropractic college graduate level credits back to UW-Platteville via the registrar's office to complete the UW-Platteville undergraduate degree requirements. This agreement will define coursework and other requirements to be completed at UW-Platteville for a student intending to matriculate at an CCE accredited chiropractic college and special criteria for awarding of the baccalaureate degree to participating students.

Objectives of the Agreement:

- 1. To attract qualified students to University of Wisconsin—Platteville.
- 2. To facilitate the transition of students from UW-Platteville to an CCE accredited chiropractic college.
- 3. To provide specific advisement for students of UW-Platteville who intend to pursue studies in the Doctor of Chiropractic (DC) at an CCE accredited chiropractic college.
- 4. To provide qualified students the opportunity to complete a baccalaureate degree and first year of the DC program in the UW-Platteville "Three Plus One" program, thus saving time and money.

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

UW-Platteville students desiring to enter a DC program are eligible to apply for admission to the DC program during their 3rd year of studies at UW-Platteville. This articulation enables University of Wisconsin-Platteville students to gain seamless transition to a DC program.

The following conditions must be met for acceptance and completed prior to the beginning of a DC program.

- Will have completed at least 90 undergraduate credit hours prior to starting the DC program, including all requirements as listed below.
- Give evidence of the pre-requisite requirements. NOTE: DC application requirements vary by chiropractic college. It is the student's responsibility to learn the requirements for the chiropractic college they wish to attend.

UW-Platteville Baccalaureate Degree Requirements:

- 1. Students will have completed at least 90 undergraduate credits. Eligible students will be admitted to a DC program at a CCE accredited chiropractic college. Upon completion of the first year of studies at chiropractic college, the college credits earned with a grade of "C" or better in the DC program will be transferred back to UW-Platteville as Biology 3000T coursework to be applied toward the undergraduate degree in biology or health sciences granted from UW-Platteville. An official transcript must be sent from the chiropractic college to UW-Platteville's Registrar's Office, and the student must request application materials for graduation from the UW-Platteville Registrar's Office.
- 2. The student must have earned at least 120 credits total to meet graduation requirements.
- 3. Students must have completed all general education requirements for UW-Platteville.
- 4. Students must have earned at least 42 credits of upper division coursework.
- 5. The requirement of 23 of the last 32 credits being completed in residence at UW-Platteville is waived for students under this articulation. However, students must complete at least 32 credits at UW-Platteville at some point.
- 6. Students must have completed the required courses for the major. https://catalog.uwplatt.edu/undergraduate/business-industry-life-science-agriculture/biology/bs/
- 7. At least 12 upper division credits in the major must be taken through UW-Platteville.

FINANCES

Students shall pay the appropriate tuition and fees to each institution for all course work taken at that institution. During their first year of study at chiropractic college, students typically will not be registered for courses at UW-Platteville. Upon completion of the first year of study at chiropractic college, students are responsible for sending the official chiropractic college transcript to the UW-Platteville registrar's office. UW-Platteville will then award the Bachelor of Science with a major in biology or health sciences. Students may apply for financial aid at the university they are attending.

SUMMARY

Students participating in this "Three Plus One" program will successfully complete 90 credits of baccalaureate studies including designated chiropractic college prerequisite courses, as well as UW-Platteville general education requirements and major requirements, as outlined in the agreement. Successfully completed DC coursework will transfer to UW-Platteville as Biology 3000T credit and count as credit toward the undergraduate degree granted by UW-Platteville.

STUDENT ADVISEMENT

An appropriate faculty or staff member at UW-Platteville shall be assigned and responsible to advise students regarding their academic preparation for admission to a DC Program and for their ultimate goal of becoming a Doctor of Chiropractic. This advisement shall include attention to special requirements for continuation in the DC program, including the completion of the baccalaureate degree prior to starting the second year of the DC program.

CONTINUATION AND TERMINATION OF THE AGREEMENT

This agreement shall be in force until UW-Platteville makes a decision in writing to terminate it. It is agreed that, if terminated, UW-Platteville will honor the agreement until all students already admitted are given the opportunity to complete the program in a timely manner.
